

House Bill 2306

Introduced and printed pursuant to House Rule 12.00. Pre-session filed (at the request of Governor Kate Brown for Oregon Health Authority)

SUMMARY

The following summary is not prepared by the sponsors of the measure and is not a part of the body thereof subject to consideration by the Legislative Assembly. It is an editor's brief statement of the essential features of the measure **as introduced**.

Directs Oregon Health Authority to adopt rules requiring sharing of information between entities concerning criminal defendants lacking fitness to proceed. Specifies what shared information must include.

A BILL FOR AN ACT

2 Relating to defendants lacking fitness to proceed.

3 **Be It Enacted by the People of the State of Oregon:**

4 **SECTION 1. (1) The Oregon Health Authority shall adopt rules requiring that information**
5 **concerning defendants lacking fitness to proceed be shared between the authority, state**
6 **mental hospitals, law enforcement agencies, courts and county programs.**

7 **(2) The rules described in subsection (1) of this section shall specify that the information**
8 **that must be shared includes but is not limited to the defendant's diagnosis, acuity level,**
9 **treatment plan, discharge status, time spent in custody and charges and the identity of the**
10 **sentencing judge.**
