- Hemp Commission, the Director of Agriculture shall appoint, as temporary members of the commission who must be producers of industrial hemp, individuals representing industrial hemp growers that are registered under ORS 571.305.
- (2) The director must make appointments under ORS 576.206 (1) for the Oregon Industrial Hemp Commission on or before January 1, 2018.
- SECTION 4. In making appointments under ORS 576.206 (3) for the Oregon Industrial Hemp Commission, the Director of Agriculture shall appoint, as commissioners who must be producers of industrial hemp, individuals representing industrial hemp growers that are registered under ORS 571.305.
 - SECTION 5. Section 3 of this 2017 Act is repealed on January 2, 2018.
