House Bill 2380

Sponsored by Representative BARRETO; Representatives ESQUIVEL, NEARMAN, WHISNANT (at the request of La Grande Chief of Police Brian Harvey) (Presession filed.)

SUMMARY

The following summary is not prepared by the sponsors of the measure and is not a part of the body thereof subject to consideration by the Legislative Assembly. It is an editor's brief statement of the essential features of the measure **as introduced.**

Creates crime of threatening a mass injury event. Punishes by maximum of five years' imprisonment, \$125,000 fine, or both.

A BILL FOR AN ACT

- 2 Relating to threatening a mass injury event; creating new provisions; and amending ORS 161.005.
 - Be It Enacted by the People of the State of Oregon:
 - SECTION 1. (1) A person commits the crime of threatening a mass injury event if:
 - (a) The person knowingly causes fear, alarm or terror to another person by conveying a threat to cause unlawful serious physical injury or death to two or more persons;
 - (b) The person expresses the intent to carry out the threat; and
 - (c) A reasonable person would believe that the threat was likely to be carried out.
 - (2) A threat under this section may be conveyed orally, in writing or telephonically, or may be an electronic threat as defined in ORS 166.065.
 - (3) Threatening a mass injury event is a Class C felony.
