SUMMARY

The following summary is not prepared by the sponsors of the measure and is not a part of the body thereof subject to consideration by the Legislative Assembly. It is an editor's brief statement of the essential features of the measure as introduced.

Requires Oregon Health Authority to submit blueprint for basic health plan to Centers for Medicare and Medicaid Services by December 31, 2017.

Declares emergency, effective on passage.

- 2 Relating to access to health care; and declaring an emergency.
- 3 Be It Enacted by the People of the State of Oregon:
 - SECTION 1. (1) The Oregon Health Authority shall, no later than December 31, 2017, submit for certification by the Centers for Medicare and Medicaid Services a blueprint for a basic health plan in accordance with 42 U.S.C. 18051 and 42 C.F.R. part 600.
 - (2) Immediately after receiving certification of the blueprint by the Centers for Medicare and Medicaid Services, the authority shall notify the committees or interim committees related to health in the House of Representatives and the Senate.
 - SECTION 2. Section 1 of this 2017 Act is repealed December 31, 2019.
 - SECTION 3. This 2017 Act being necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health and safety, an emergency is declared to exist, and this 2017 Act takes effect on its passage.

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
