## House Bill 2436

Sponsored by Representative PARRISH (Presession filed.)

## **SUMMARY**

The following summary is not prepared by the sponsors of the measure and is not a part of the body thereof subject to consideration by the Legislative Assembly. It is an editor's brief statement of the essential features of the measure **as introduced.** 

Provides for payment of program expenses of study abroad program for eligible students.

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- 2 Relating to study abroad programs.
- 3 Be It Enacted by the People of the State of Oregon:
- 4 SECTION 1. (1) As used in this section:
- 5 (a) "Eligible student" means a student who meets academic requirements prescribed by 6 the State Board of Education by rule and who:
  - (A) Is in the care of a foster parent;
- 8 (B) Is a ward of the state; or

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- 9 (C) Is eligible for free or reduced price lunches under the United States Department of 10 Agriculture's current Income Eligibility Guidelines.
  - (b) "Program expenses" includes:
- 12 (A) Tuition, fees and books for a study abroad program;
- 13 (B) Lodging for the duration of a study abroad program;
- 14 (C) Travel to and from a study abroad program; and
- 15 (D) Nominal incidentals that normally would be incurred as part of a study abroad pro-16 gram, as identified by the State Board of Education by rule.
  - (c) "Study abroad program" means an education program for grade 11 or 12 that:
  - (A) Is provided in a country other than the United States; and
  - (B) Provides courses that satisfy requirements for a high school diploma, as prescribed under ORS 329.451.
  - (2) An eligible student may have the program expenses of a study abroad program paid for as provided by this section.
  - (3) The program expenses of a study abroad program may be paid as provided by this section only if the program meets the requirements prescribed by the State Board of Education, as determined by the Department of Education.
  - (4)(a) The Department of Education shall make a distribution for an eligible student participating in a study abroad program in an amount that equals the lesser of:
    - (A) The program expenses of a study abroad program; or
  - (B) An amount determined by the Department of Education each school year to equal the average per student distribution of moneys from the State School Fund as general purpose grants for all school districts in this state, without any adjustments by weight as described in ORS 327.013 (1)(c)(A).

**NOTE:** Matter in **boldfaced** type in an amended section is new; matter [*italic and bracketed*] is existing law to be omitted. New sections are in **boldfaced** type.

- (b) A distribution made under paragraph (a) of this subsection shall be deducted from the general purpose grant for the school district in which the eligible student is a resident.
- (c) The State Board of Education shall prescribe by rule the manner in which distributions are made under this subsection.
- (5)(a) Notwithstanding subsection (4) of this section, if the program expenses of a study abroad program are more than the amount determined under subsection (4)(a)(B) of this section, the eligible student must provide the difference between the program expenses and the amount determined under subsection (4)(a)(B) in order for a distribution to be made under subsection (4) of this section.
- (b) The Department of Education or a school district may solicit and accept gifts, grants, donations and other moneys from public and private sources for the purpose of assisting an eligible student with the amount of any difference described under paragraph (a) of this subsection.
