House Bill 2440

Sponsored by Representative PARRISH (Presession filed.)

SUMMARY

The following summary is not prepared by the sponsors of the measure and is not a part of the body thereof subject to consideration by the Legislative Assembly. It is an editor's brief statement of the essential features of the measure **as introduced**.

Directs Department of Transportation to remove high occupancy vehicle lane restrictions on Interstate 5 in Portland.

Declares emergency, effective on passage.

A BILL FOR AN ACT

2 Relating to high occupancy vehicle lanes; and declaring an emergency.

3 Be It Enacted by the People of the State of Oregon:

4 <u>SECTION 1.</u> The Department of Transportation may not restrict the use of any lane on 5 Interstate 5 in Portland based on the number of occupants traveling in a vehicle.

6 SECTION 2. On or before January 1, 2018, the Department of Transportation shall take

7 all action necessary to remove any restrictions on the use of any lane on Interstate 5 in

8 Portland if the restriction is based on the number of occupants traveling in a vehicle.

9 SECTION 3. This 2017 Act being necessary for the immediate preservation of the public
10 peace, health and safety, an emergency is declared to exist, and this 2017 Act takes effect
11 on its passage.
