House Bill 2475

SUMMARY

The following summary is not prepared by the sponsors of the measure and is not a part of the body thereof subject to consideration by the Legislative Assembly. It is an editor's brief statement of the essential features of the measure **as introduced.**

Allows skilled nursing facilities to temporarily employ nurses holding license issued by another state while license from Oregon State Board of Nursing is pending.

3	Be It Enacted by the People of the State of Oregon:
4	SECTION 1. Section 2 of this 2017 Act is added to and made a part of ORS chapter 678.
5	SECTION 2. (1) Notwithstanding ORS 678.021 and 678.023, a skilled nursing facility, a
6	defined in ORS 442.015, may employ an applicant for a license under ORS 678.050 who has no
7	yet been issued the license if:
8	(a) The applicant provides proof to the skilled nursing facility of application for licensure
9	(b) The applicant holds a license to practice nursing issued by a licensing agency of an
10	other state or territory of the United States; and
11	(c) The license issued under paragraph (b) of this subsection is in good standing.
12	(2) A skilled nursing facility may employ a person described in subsection (1) of thi
13	section for up to 120 calendar days.
