House Bill 2479

Sponsored by Representative BENTZ (at the request of Saint Alphonsus Medical Center Ontario, Treasure Valley Community College) (Presession filed.)

SUMMARY

The following summary is not prepared by the sponsors of the measure and is not a part of the body thereof subject to consideration by the Legislative Assembly. It is an editor's brief statement of the essential features of the measure **as introduced.**

Requires Oregon Health and Science University to create program to enable students to receive bachelor's degree in nursing while taking all required classes at Treasure Valley Community College.

A BILL FOR AN ACT

- 2 Relating to nursing degrees at Treasure Valley Community College.
 - Be It Enacted by the People of the State of Oregon:
 - <u>SECTION 1.</u> (1) The Oregon Health and Science University shall establish a program that enables students to receive a bachelor's degree in nursing from the university while having all required classes taught at the Treasure Valley Community College campus.
 - (2) The Oregon Health and Science University, in consultation with the board of education of the Treasure Valley Community College District, may adopt rules to carry out the provisions of this section.
 - SECTION 2. In addition to and not in lieu of any other appropriation, there is appropriated to the Higher Education Coordinating Commission, for the biennium beginning July 1, 2017, out of the General Fund, the amount of \$870,000 for distribution to the Treasure Valley Community College District and the Oregon Health and Science University for the purpose of implementing section 1 of this 2017 Act.
 - SECTION 3. The Oregon Health and Science University shall first admit students into the program established in section 1 of this 2017 Act during the 2018-2019 academic year.
