3	Be It Enacted by the People of the State of Oregon:
4	SECTION 1. Each school district shall ensure that students of the school district have
5	access to qualified guidance counselors who are:
6	(1) Licensed by the Teacher Standards and Practices Commission as a school counselor
7	or
8	(2) Qualified to be a licensed school counselor through education or experience and who
9	have received professional development on the delivery of comprehensive school counseling
10	services in accordance with rules adopted by the State Board of Education.
