SUMMARY

The following summary is not prepared by the sponsors of the measure and is not a part of the body thereof subject to consideration by the Legislative Assembly. It is an editor's brief statement of the essential features of the measure.

Appropriates moneys from General Fund to State Workforce Investment Board for **distribution** to Worksystems, Inc. [for training and case management of 1,000 potential job applicants in East Portland and East Multnomah County in advanced electronics, advanced metal and machinery manufacturing and distribution] to implement pilot program to provide targeted sector career coaching, occupational training and job placement for job seekers in areas of concentrated poverty statewide.

Declares emergency, effective July 1, 2017.

A BILL FOR AN ACT

2 Relating to state financial administration; and declaring an emergency.

3 Be It Enacted by the People of the State of Oregon:

4 <u>SECTION 1.</u> In addition to and not in lieu of any other appropriation, there is appropri-

5 ated to the State Workforce Investment Board, for the biennium beginning July 1, 2017, out

6 of the General Fund, the amount of \$5,000,000, for distribution to Worksystems, Inc. to im-

7 plement a pilot program to provide targeted sector career coaching, occupational training

8 and job placement for job seekers in areas of concentrated poverty statewide.

9 SECTION 2. This 2017 Act being necessary for the immediate preservation of the public
10 peace, health and safety, an emergency is declared to exist, and this 2017 Act takes effect
11 July 1, 2017.
