

# House Bill 2542

Sponsored by Representative HACK (Pre-session filed.)

## SUMMARY

The following summary is not prepared by the sponsors of the measure and is not a part of the body thereof subject to consideration by the Legislative Assembly. It is an editor's brief statement of the essential features of the measure **as introduced**.

Allows court to impose restrictions on use of moneys awarded in certain judgments against State of Oregon.

Declares emergency, effective on passage.

## A BILL FOR AN ACT

1  
2 Relating to lawsuits against the State of Oregon; and declaring an emergency.

3 **Be It Enacted by the People of the State of Oregon:**

4 **SECTION 1. Section 2 of this 2017 Act is added to and made a part of ORS chapter 18.**

5 **SECTION 2. In any civil action in which a party that is not a natural person obtains a**  
6 **judgment against the State of Oregon that includes a money award, the court may include**  
7 **in the judgment restrictions requiring the moneys awarded to be used for specific purposes**  
8 **related to the action and requiring the party to provide accountings of the use of the moneys**  
9 **awarded to the court. If the party does not comply with the restrictions included in the**  
10 **judgment under this section, the court may set aside or modify the judgment under ORS**  
11 **18.082.**

12 **SECTION 3. Section 2 of this 2017 Act applies only to judgments entered on or after the**  
13 **effective date of this 2017 Act.**

14 **SECTION 4. This 2017 Act being necessary for the immediate preservation of the public**  
15 **peace, health and safety, an emergency is declared to exist, and this 2017 Act takes effect**  
16 **on its passage.**
