

# House Bill 2553

Sponsored by Representative HACK (Pre-session filed.)

## SUMMARY

The following summary is not prepared by the sponsors of the measure and is not a part of the body thereof subject to consideration by the Legislative Assembly. It is an editor's brief statement of the essential features of the measure **as introduced**.

Directs Legislative Revenue Officer to study impediments under state law that prevent cities one-third of whose property tax base is owned by state agencies or public universities from applying for matching federal economic development grants.

3 **Be It Enacted by the People of the State of Oregon:**

4 **SECTION 1. The Legislative Revenue Officer shall conduct a study of the impediments**  
5 **under state law that prevent cities one-third of whose property tax base is owned by state**  
6 **agencies or public universities from applying for matching federal economic development**  
7 **grants.**
