Directs Office of Emergency Management to identify strategies for improving access to emergency preparedness education. Sunsets January 2, 2020.

3	Be It Enacted by the People of the State of Oregon:
4	SECTION 1. (1) The Office of Emergency Management shall conduct a study to identify
5	strategies for improving access to emergency preparedness education for Oregon residents
6	and shall make a report on its findings.
7	(2) The office shall submit the report required by subsection (1) of this section, and may
8	include recommendations for legislation, to the Legislative Assembly in the manner provided
9	under ORS 192.245 no later than July 31, 2019.
10	SECTION 2. Section 1 of this 2017 Act is repealed on January 2, 2020.
