

House Bill 2574

Sponsored by Representative GOMBERG (Pre-session filed.)

SUMMARY

The following summary is not prepared by the sponsors of the measure and is not a part of the body thereof subject to consideration by the Legislative Assembly. It is an editor's brief statement of the essential features of the measure **as introduced**.

Directs Office of Emergency Management to identify strategies for improving access to emergency preparedness education.

Sunsets January 2, 2020.

A BILL FOR AN ACT

1
2 Relating to emergency preparedness education.

3 **Be It Enacted by the People of the State of Oregon:**

4 **SECTION 1. (1) The Office of Emergency Management shall conduct a study to identify**
5 **strategies for improving access to emergency preparedness education for Oregon residents**
6 **and shall make a report on its findings.**

7 **(2) The office shall submit the report required by subsection (1) of this section, and may**
8 **include recommendations for legislation, to the Legislative Assembly in the manner provided**
9 **under ORS 192.245 no later than July 31, 2019.**

10 **SECTION 2. Section 1 of this 2017 Act is repealed on January 2, 2020.**
