

House Bill 2575

Sponsored by Representative GOMBERG (Pre-session filed.)

SUMMARY

The following summary is not prepared by the sponsors of the measure and is not a part of the body thereof subject to consideration by the Legislative Assembly. It is an editor's brief statement of the essential features of the measure **as introduced**.

Expands exemption from requirement to equip vehicle with brakes to include balance trailers that transport dories.

A BILL FOR AN ACT

2 Relating to exemptions from vehicle brake requirements; creating new provisions; and amending
3 ORS 815.135.

4 **Be It Enacted by the People of the State of Oregon:**

5 **SECTION 1.** ORS 815.135 is amended to read:

6 815.135. This section establishes exemptions from ORS 815.130. The exemptions under this sec-
7 tion are in addition to any exemptions under ORS 801.026. The exemptions under this section are
8 partial or complete as described in the following:

9 (1) The following vehicles shall be deemed in compliance with the brake requirements if the
10 vehicles are equipped with original manufacturer's equipment and accessories, or their equivalent,
11 and maintained in safe operating condition:

12 (a) Except as provided in subsection (2) of this section, vehicles of special interest that are
13 registered under ORS 805.020.

14 (b) Antique vehicles that are registered under ORS 805.010.

15 (2) Vehicles of special interest that are registered under ORS 805.020 and that are street rods,
16 as defined in ORS 801.513, shall be deemed in compliance with the brake requirements if the street
17 rods conform to ORS 815.107.

18 (3) The following vehicles are exempt from the brake requirements:

19 (a) Road machinery.

20 (b) Road rollers.

21 (c) Farm tractors.

22 (d) Electric personal assistive mobility devices.

23 (e) **Balance trailers transporting a dory.**

24 **SECTION 2.** The amendments to ORS 815.135 by section 1 of this 2017 Act apply to con-
25 duct occurring on or after the effective date of this 2017 Act.
