SUMMARY

The following summary is not prepared by the sponsors of the measure and is not a part of the body thereof subject to consideration by the Legislative Assembly. It is an editor's brief statement of the essential features of the measure.

Expands offense of vehicular assault to include contact with motorcycle, motorcycle operator or motorcycle passenger.

Provides that vehicular assault statute be known and may be cited as Milkman Mike Act.

A BILL FOR AN ACT

Relating to the offense of vehicular assault; creating new provisions; and amending ORS 811.060.

Be It Enacted by the People of the State of Oregon:

SECTION 1. ORS 811.060 is amended to read:

811.060. (1) For the purposes of this section, "recklessly" has the meaning given that term in ORS 161.085.

(2) A person commits the offense of vehicular assault [*of a bicyclist or pedestrian*] if:

(a) The person recklessly operates a vehicle upon a highway in a manner that results in contact between the person's vehicle and:

(A) A bicycle operated by a person[.];

(B) A person operating a bicycle [*or a pedestrian*]; [*and*]

(C) **A motorcycle operated by a person;**

(D) **A person operating a motorcycle;**

(E) **A passenger on a motorcycle; or**

(F) **A pedestrian; and**

(b) The contact causes physical injury to the person operating a bicycle, **the person operating a motorcycle, the passenger on a motorcycle** or the pedestrian.

(3) The offense described in this section, vehicular assault [*of a bicyclist or pedestrian*], is a Class A misdemeanor.

SECTION 2. The amendments to ORS 811.060 by section 1 of this 2017 Act apply to conduct occurring on or after the effective date of this 2017 Act.

SECTION 3. ORS 811.060 shall be known and may be cited as the Milkman Mike Act.
