CHAPTER .....

AN ACT

Relating to the Oregon Uniform Trust Code; amending section 5, chapter 126, Oregon Laws 2015; and declaring an emergency.

**Be It Enacted by the People of the State of Oregon:**

**SECTION 1.** Section 5, chapter 126, Oregon Laws 2015, is amended to read:

**Sec. 5.** The amendments to ORS 130.230, 130.232, 130.715 and 130.730 by sections 1 to 4, **chapter 126, Oregon Laws 2015, [of this 2015 Act]** apply **only** to trusts executed on or after [*the effective date of this 2015 Act*] **January 1, 2016, and to trust proceedings commenced on or after the effective date of this 2017 Act, regardless of when the trust at issue was executed.**

**SECTION 2.** **This 2017 Act being necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health and safety, an emergency is declared to exist, and this 2017 Act takes effect on its passage.**
