Modifies applicability of previous amendments to Oregon Uniform Trust Code. Declares emergency, effective on passage.

4	Be It Enacted by the People of the State of Oregon:
5	SECTION 1. Section 5, chapter 126, Oregon Laws 2015, is amended to read:
6	Sec. 5. The amendments to ORS 130.230, 130.232, 130.715 and 130.730 by sections 1 to 4, chapter
7	126, Oregon Laws 2015, [of this 2015 Act] apply only to trusts executed on or after [the effective
8	date of this 2015 Act] January 1, 2016, and to trust proceedings commenced on or after the
9	effective date of this 2017 Act, regardless of when the trust at issue was executed.
10	SECTION 2. This 2017 Act being necessary for the immediate preservation of the public
11	peace, health and safety, an emergency is declared to exist, and this 2017 Act takes effect
12	on its passage.
