SUMMARY

The following summary is not prepared by the sponsors of the measure and is not a part of the body thereof subject to consideration by the Legislative Assembly. It is an editor's brief statement of the essential features of the measure **as introduced.**

Modifies annual salaries of judges of Supreme Court, Court of Appeals, Oregon Tax Court and circuit courts.

Takes effect on 91st day following adjournment sine die.

 - 292.406. (1)(a) The annual salary of the Chief Judge of the Court of Appeals shall be [\$135,688 for the year beginning January 1, 2015, and for each year thereafter] \$147,559.92 for the period beginning on January 1, 2017, and ending on December 31, 2017.
 - (b) On January 1[, 2017] of 2018, 2019 and 2020, the annual salary of the Chief Judge of the Court of Appeals, as adjusted under ORS 292.428, shall be increased by [\$5,000] \$6,863.
 - (2)(a) The annual salary of each other judge of the Court of Appeals shall be [\$132,820 for the year beginning January 1, 2015, and for each year thereafter] \$144,535.92 for the period beginning on January 1, 2017, and ending on December 31, 2017.
 - (b) On January 1[, 2017] of 2018, 2019 and 2020, the annual salary of each other judge of the Court of Appeals, as adjusted under ORS 292.428, shall be increased by [\$5,000] \$6,821.
