## House Bill 2652

Sponsored by Representative DOHERTY (Presession filed.)

## **SUMMARY**

The following summary is not prepared by the sponsors of the measure and is not a part of the body thereof subject to consideration by the Legislative Assembly. It is an editor's brief statement of the essential features of the measure **as introduced.** 

Allows Department of Education to enter into agreement with certain school districts for reimbursement of cost of providing school meals. Directs State Board of Education to adopt rules related to reimbursement.

A BILL FOR AN ACT

Declares emergency, effective July 1, 2017.

## Relating to school meal programs; and declaring an emergency. 3 Be It Enacted by the People of the State of Oregon: SECTION 1. (1) The Department of Education may enter into a written agreement with 4 5 a school district that qualifies under the Community Eligibility Provision of the federal Na-6 tional School Lunch Act (42 U.S.C. 1759a(a)(1)) to reimburse the school district for the por-7 tion of the cost of providing meals to students that is not reimbursed by the United States 8 Department of Agriculture. 9 (2) A school district shall request reimbursement from the Department of Education in 10 a manner established by the department by rule. 11 (3)(a) The State Board of Education shall establish by rule criteria for reimbursement 12 by the Department of Education under subsection (1) of this section. (b) The board may adopt other rules necessary for the administration of this section. 13 14 SECTION 2. In addition to and not in lieu of any other appropriation, there is appropriated to the Department of Education, for the biennium beginning July 1, 2017, out of the 15 General Fund, the amount of \$\_\_\_\_\_, which may be expended for the purposes of section 1 16 17 of this 2017 Act. 18 SECTION 3. Section 1 of this 2017 Act first applies to the 2017-2018 school year. SECTION 4. This 2017 Act being necessary for the immediate preservation of the public 19 20 peace, health and safety, an emergency is declared to exist, and this 2017 Act takes effect 21 July 1, 2017.
