

HOUSE AMENDMENTS TO HOUSE BILL 2660

1 Delete lines 4 through 19 of the printed corrected bill and insert:

2 **“SECTION 1. (1) The Oregon Health Authority shall make written materials available on**
3 **the authority’s website to educate breast cancer patients about the availability of insurance**
4 **coverage for breast reconstruction surgery and breast prostheses following a mastectomy.**
5 **The authority shall update the materials at least annually.**

6 **“(2) The authority shall place a link to the educational materials described in subsection**
7 **(1) of this section next to a link on the website to information about breast cancer screenings**
8 **and under a tab designated ‘Breast Reconstruction Education.’ The materials must include**
9 **links to information about breast reconstruction surgery published by governmental entities**
10 **with a nexus to this state or nonprofit organizations with expertise in breast reconstruction**
11 **surgery, including but not limited to information about:**

12 **“(a) The availability of the option to have breast reconstruction surgery following a**
13 **mastectomy including that the breast reconstruction surgery may be performed at the time**
14 **of a mastectomy or may be delayed until a later date.**

15 **“(b) Prostheses or breast forms as alternatives to breast reconstruction surgery.**

16 **“(c) The requirements of the Women’s Health and Cancer Rights Act of 1998 (P.L.**
17 **105-277) including the right to breast reconstruction surgery following a mastectomy even if**
18 **the surgery is delayed until a later date.**

19 **“(3) The authority may include educational information about breast reconstruction**
20 **surgery in newsletters or similar publications that the authority sends to clients or physi-**
21 **cians on a weekly or monthly basis.**

22 **“SECTION 2. (1) The Department of Consumer and Business Services shall make written**
23 **materials available on the department’s website to educate breast cancer patients about the**
24 **availability of insurance coverage for breast reconstruction surgery and breast prostheses**
25 **following a mastectomy. The department shall update the materials at least annually.**

26 **“(2) The department shall place a link to the educational materials described in sub-**
27 **section (1) of this section close to links on the website to information for consumers about**
28 **health insurance and under a tab designated ‘Breast Reconstruction Education.’ The mate-**
29 **rials must include links to information about breast reconstruction surgery published by**
30 **governmental entities with a nexus to this state or nonprofit organizations with expertise in**
31 **breast reconstruction surgery, including but not limited to information about:**

32 **“(a) The availability of the option to have breast reconstruction surgery following a**
33 **mastectomy including that the breast reconstruction surgery may be performed at the time**
34 **of a mastectomy or may be delayed until a later date.**

35 **“(b) Prostheses or breast forms as alternatives to breast reconstruction surgery.**

1 “(c) The requirements of the Women’s Health and Cancer Rights Act of 1998 (P.L.
2 105-277) including the right to breast reconstruction surgery following a mastectomy even if
3 the surgery is delayed until a later date.

4 “(3) The department may include educational information about breast reconstruction
5 surgery in newsletters or similar publications that the department sends to consumers or
6 carriers on a weekly or monthly basis.”.

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
