

House Bill 2708

Sponsored by Representative HELM (Pre-session filed.)

SUMMARY

The following summary is not prepared by the sponsors of the measure and is not a part of the body thereof subject to consideration by the Legislative Assembly. It is an editor's brief statement of the essential features of the measure **as introduced**.

Directs Land Conservation and Development Commission to amend statewide land use planning goal, guidelines and rules to reflect current bioengineering measures for conservation of beaches and dunes.

A BILL FOR AN ACT

2 Relating to bioengineering measures in statewide land use planning goals.

3 **Be It Enacted by the People of the State of Oregon:**

4 **SECTION 1. Section 2 of this 2017 Act is added to and made a part of ORS chapter 197.**

5 **SECTION 2. In order to ensure that the statewide land use planning goals reflect current**
6 **available conservation and protection methods, the Land Conservation and Development**
7 **Commission shall adopt, amend or repeal the statewide land use planning goal relating to**
8 **beaches and dunes and corresponding guidelines and rules as necessary to incorporate cur-**
9 **rent bioengineering measures as permissible shoreline protective measures.**
