## House Bill 2794

Sponsored by COMMITTEE ON JUDICIARY

## SUMMARY

The following summary is not prepared by the sponsors of the measure and is not a part of the body thereof subject to consideration by the Legislative Assembly. It is an editor's brief statement of the essential features of the measure **as introduced**.

Reduces penalties for crime of possession of gambling records in the second degree. Punishes by maximum of six months' imprisonment, \$2,500 fine, or both.

3	Be It Enacted by the People of the State of Oregon:
4	<b>SECTION 1.</b> ORS 167.132 is amended to read:
5	167.132. (1) A person commits the crime of possession of gambling records in the second degree
6	if, with knowledge of the contents thereof, the person possesses any writing, paper, instrument or
7	article:
8	(a) Of a kind commonly used in the operation or promotion of a bookmaking scheme or enter-
9	prise; or
10	(b) Of a kind commonly used in the operation, promotion or playing of a lottery or numbers
11	scheme or enterprise.
12	(2) Possession of gambling records in the second degree is a Class $[A]$ B misdemeanor.
