

House Bill 2800

Sponsored by COMMITTEE ON JUDICIARY

SUMMARY

The following summary is not prepared by the sponsors of the measure and is not a part of the body thereof subject to consideration by the Legislative Assembly. It is an editor's brief statement of the essential features of the measure **as introduced**.

Directs Oregon Criminal Justice Commission to conduct study on long-term consequences of criminal convictions and present report on findings to interim committees of Legislative Assembly related to judiciary on or before September 15, 2018.

Sunsets January 2, 2019.

2 Relating to convictions.

3 **Be It Enacted by the People of the State of Oregon:**

4 **SECTION 1. The Oregon Criminal Justice Commission shall conduct a study on the**
5 **long-term consequences of criminal convictions, including housing and employment oppor-**
6 **tunities, and present the results of the study, along with any recommended legislative**
7 **changes, in a report to the interim committees of the Legislative Assembly related to the**
8 **judiciary in the manner provided under ORS 192.245 on or before September 15, 2018.**

9 **SECTION 2. Section 1 of this 2017 Act is repealed on January 2, 2019.**
