

House Bill 2810

Sponsored by COMMITTEE ON JUDICIARY

SUMMARY

The following summary is not prepared by the sponsors of the measure and is not a part of the body thereof subject to consideration by the Legislative Assembly. It is an editor's brief statement of the essential features of the measure **as introduced**.

Directs Administrator of the Division of Child Support of the Department of Justice to conduct statewide study regarding child support no later than July 1, 2018.

Requires administrator to submit report regarding study to interim legislative committees no later than November 1, 2018.

Sunsets January 1, 2019.

Declares emergency, effective on passage.

A BILL FOR AN ACT

2 Relating to child support; and declaring an emergency.

3 **Be It Enacted by the People of the State of Oregon:**

4 **SECTION 1. (1) No later than July 1, 2018, the Administrator of the Division of Child**
5 **Support of the Department of Justice shall conduct a statewide study regarding the estab-**
6 **lishment, modification and enforcement of child support orders in this state. The adminis-**
7 **trator shall collaborate with the office of the Attorney General and district attorney offices**
8 **in conducting the study under this subsection.**

9 (2) No later than November 1, 2018, the administrator shall submit a report to the in-
10 terim legislative committees related to child welfare and domestic relations regarding the
11 study conducted in accordance with subsection (1) of this section.

12 **SECTION 2. Section 1 of this 2017 Act is repealed on January 1, 2019.**

13 **SECTION 3. This 2017 Act being necessary for the immediate preservation of the public**
14 **peace, health and safety, an emergency is declared to exist, and this 2017 Act takes effect**
15 **on its passage.**
