

House Bill 2871

Sponsored by COMMITTEE ON RULES

SUMMARY

The following summary is not prepared by the sponsors of the measure and is not a part of the body thereof subject to consideration by the Legislative Assembly. It is an editor's brief statement of the essential features of the measure **as introduced**.

Requires Secretary of State to conduct study to determine most effective method of enabling electors to use registration card to request voting materials in language other than English.

A BILL FOR AN ACT

2 Relating to minority language voting materials.

3 **Be It Enacted by the People of the State of Oregon:**

4 **SECTION 1. (1) As used in this section:**

5 (a) **"Registration card" has the meaning given that term in ORS 247.002; and**

6 (b) **"Voting materials" means any elector registration or voting notices, forms, in-**
7 **structions, assistance or other information relating to the electoral process, including but**
8 **not limited to:**

9 (A) **Elector registration forms;**

10 (B) **Mailed ballots;**

11 (C) **Measures and instructions for how to cast a vote;**

12 (D) **Ballot titles; and**

13 (E) **Voters' pamphlets.**

14 (2) **The Secretary of State shall conduct a study to determine the most effective method**
15 **of enabling electors to use a registration card to request voting materials in a language other**
16 **than English.**

17 (3) **The Secretary of State shall report the results of the study conducted under sub-**
18 **section (2) of this section to the interim legislative committees responsible for elections no**
19 **later than October 31, 2018.**
