SUMMARY

The following summary is not prepared by the sponsors of the measure and is not a part of the body thereof subject to consideration by the Legislative Assembly. It is an editor's brief statement of the essential features of the measure **as introduced**.

Appropriates moneys to Department of Human Services for Oregon Hunger Response Fund program services.

Declares emergency, effective on passage.

A BILL FOR AN ACT

2 Relating to Oregon Hunger Response Fund; and declaring an emergency.

3 **Be It Enacted by the People of the State of Oregon:**

4 **SECTION 1. In addition to and not in lieu of any other appropriation, there is appropri-**
5 **ated to the Department of Human Services, for the biennium beginning July 1, 2017, out of**
6 **the General Fund, the amount of \$700,000, which may be expended for Oregon Hunger Re-**
7 **sponse Fund program services administered by the department in accordance with ORS**
8 **458.530.**

9 **SECTION 2. This 2017 Act being necessary for the immediate preservation of the public**
10 **peace, health and safety, an emergency is declared to exist, and this 2017 Act takes effect**
11 **on its passage.**
