

HOUSE AMENDMENTS TO HOUSE BILL 2886

By COMMITTEE ON VETERANS AND EMERGENCY PREPAREDNESS

1 On page 1 of the printed bill, delete lines 6 through 30.

2 On page 2, delete lines 1 through 7 and insert:

3 **“SECTION 2. (1) The Oregon Public Places Are Safe Places Investment Fund is estab-**
4 **lished in the State Treasury, separate and distinct from the General Fund.**

5 **“(2) Amounts in the Oregon Public Places Are Safe Places Investment Fund may be in-**
6 **vested as provided in ORS 293.701 to 293.857, and interest earned on moneys in the fund must**
7 **be credited to the fund.**

8 **“(3) Amounts credited to the fund are continuously appropriated to the Office of Emer-**
9 **gency Management for the implementation of strategies for identifying and developing stag-**
10 **ing areas for emergency response.**

11 **“(4) The fund consists of:**

12 **“(a) Amounts appropriated, or otherwise provided, by the Legislative Assembly for de-**
13 **posit in the fund; and**

14 **“(b) Gifts, grants or contributions received by the office for deposit in the fund.**

15 **“SECTION 3. (1) There is created within the Office of Emergency Management an advi-**
16 **sory committee to provide recommendations and advice to the office regarding expenditures**
17 **from the Oregon Public Places Are Safe Places Investment Fund established under section**
18 **2 of this 2017 Act.**

19 **“(2) The advisory committee initially consists of 26 members appointed by the Governor**
20 **as follows:**

21 **“(a) The Governor shall appoint as members one representative from each of the follow-**
22 **ing:**

23 **“(A) The Department of Consumer and Business Services;**

24 **“(B) The Department of Corrections;**

25 **“(C) The Department of Environmental Quality;**

26 **“(D) The Department of Human Services;**

27 **“(E) The Department of Justice;**

28 **“(F) The Department of Land Conservation and Development;**

29 **“(G) The Department of State Police;**

30 **“(H) The Department of Transportation;**

31 **“(I) The office of State Resilience Officer;**

32 **“(J) The Oregon Department of Administrative Services;**

33 **“(K) The Oregon Department of Aviation;**

34 **“(L) The Oregon Health Authority;**

35 **“(M) The Public Utility Commission of Oregon;**

1 **“(N) The State Department of Agriculture;**
2 **“(O) The State Department of Energy;**
3 **“(P) The State Department of Fish and Wildlife;**
4 **“(Q) The State Department of Geology and Mineral Industries;**
5 **“(R) The State Fire Marshal;**
6 **“(S) The State Forestry Department;**
7 **“(T) The State Marine Board;**
8 **“(U) The State Parks and Recreation Department;**
9 **“(V) The State Treasurer; and**
10 **“(W) The Water Resources Department.**
11 **“(b) The Governor shall appoint three members as follows:**
12 **“(A) One member representing local governments in this state;**
13 **“(B) One member representing special districts in this state; and**
14 **“(C) One member of the public who has experience or interest in disaster response and**
15 **recovery.**
16 **“(3) Appointments shall be made for a term of four years in a manner to preserve as**
17 **much as possible the representation of the advisory committee described in subsection (2)**
18 **of this section. Vacancies shall be filled for any unexpired term as soon as the Governor can**
19 **make such appointments.**
20 **“(4) The chairperson of the advisory committee may appoint additional members to the**
21 **advisory committee. Members added under this subsection serve for a term of four years.**
22 **If a member appointed under this subsection leaves service on the advisory committee for**
23 **any reason, the chairperson may appoint another person for the unexpired term.**
24 **“(5) The advisory committee shall choose its own chairperson and shall meet at the call**
25 **of the chairperson or the Director of the Office of Emergency Management. The advisory**
26 **committee shall adopt rules to govern its proceedings and may select officers it considers**
27 **necessary.**
28 **“(6) The Office of Emergency Management shall provide office space and personnel to**
29 **assist the advisory committee as requested by the chairperson, within the limits of available**
30 **funds.**
31 **“(7) Members of the advisory committee shall receive no compensation for their services.**
32 **Members of the advisory committee other than members employed in full-time public service**
33 **shall be reimbursed by the office for their actual and necessary expenses incurred in the**
34 **performance of their duties. Such reimbursements shall be subject to the provisions of ORS**
35 **to 292.288. Members of the advisory committee who are employed in full-time public service**
36 **may be reimbursed by their employing agency for their actual and necessary expenses in-**
37 **curring in the performance of their duties.”.**
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
