

House Bill 2890

Sponsored by COMMITTEE ON VETERANS AND EMERGENCY PREPAREDNESS

SUMMARY

The following summary is not prepared by the sponsors of the measure and is not a part of the body thereof subject to consideration by the Legislative Assembly. It is an editor's brief statement of the essential features of the measure **as introduced**.

Directs Oregon Military Department to submit report to interim legislative committees, no later than July 1, 2018, regarding implementation of Oregon Code of Military Justice.

Declares emergency, effective on passage.

A BILL FOR AN ACT

2 Relating to the Oregon Military Department; and declaring an emergency.

3 **Be It Enacted by the People of the State of Oregon:**

4 **SECTION 1. (1) No later than July 1, 2018, the Oregon Military Department shall submit**
5 **a report to the interim legislative committees of the Legislative Assembly on veterans' af-**
6 **fairs and military affairs regarding implementation of the Oregon Code of Military Justice**
7 **in this state.**

8 **(2) The report shall include a summary of implementation barriers and may include rec-**
9 **ommendations for legislative changes.**

10 **SECTION 2. This 2017 Act being necessary for the immediate preservation of the public**
11 **peace, health and safety, an emergency is declared to exist, and this 2017 Act takes effect**
12 **on its passage.**
