

# House Bill 2899

Sponsored by Representative BOONE; Representatives GOMBERG, MCKEOWN, SMITH DB, Senators JOHNSON, KRUSE, ROBLAN

## SUMMARY

The following summary is not prepared by the sponsors of the measure and is not a part of the body thereof subject to consideration by the Legislative Assembly. It is an editor's brief statement of the essential features of the measure **as introduced**.

Provides that ports may enter into intergovernmental agreements for any purpose permitted under ORS chapter 190.

## A BILL FOR AN ACT

2 Relating to intergovernmental agreements by ports; amending ORS 777.112.

3 **Be It Enacted by the People of the State of Oregon:**

4 **SECTION 1.** ORS 777.112 is amended to read:

5 777.112. (1) A port may enter into intergovernmental agreements under ORS chapter 190[.] **for**  
6 **any purpose permitted under that chapter.**

7 *[(a) To provide facilities or services that any of the parties to the agreement might provide or per-*  
8 *form separately for the improvement or maintenance of the bays, harbors and channels of the Columbia*  
9 *River and other Oregon rivers and streams; or]*

10 *[(b) To exercise the powers that any of the parties to the agreement has to control the use of the*  
11 *waters, shores and banks thereof.]*

12 (2) Any port may enter into a contract with any person or into an intergovernmental agreement  
13 under ORS chapter 190 for the use and control of water for promoting erosion control, pollution  
14 control or otherwise protecting, maintaining and enhancing waters within the boundaries of the port  
15 district.

16 (3) Expenses incurred or revenues received in the performance of a contract or agreement en-  
17 tered into under subsections (1) and (2) of this section shall be allocated among the parties as the  
18 contract or agreement shall provide.
