

House Bill 2900

SUMMARY

The following summary is not prepared by the sponsors of the measure and is not a part of the body thereof subject to consideration by the Legislative Assembly. It is an editor's brief statement of the essential features of the measure **as introduced**.

Authorizes ports to advertise activities of port and activities of others using port facilities.

A BILL FOR AN ACT

2 Relating to advertising by ports; amending ORS 777.240.

3 **Be It Enacted by the People of the State of Oregon:**

4 **SECTION 1.** ORS 777.240 is amended to read:

5 777.240. A port may advertise and promote [*the*] facilities and commerce of the port, **activities**
6 **of the port and activities of others using port facilities**, through public and trade media, exhib-
7 its, fairs, trade fairs and trade tours, either alone or in cooperation with others or through associ-
8 ations or organizations having similar interests.
