

HOUSE AMENDMENTS TO HOUSE BILL 2906

By JOINT COMMITTEE ON WAYS AND MEANS

1 On page 1 of the printed bill, line 2, delete “declaring an emergency” and insert “prescribing
2 an effective date”.

3 On page 2, after line 28, insert:

4 “(K) One member who is a geographic information systems manager for a county or city in this
5 state;”.

6 In line 29, delete “(K)” and insert “(L)”.

7 In line 31, delete “(L)” and insert “(M)”.

8 In line 33, delete “(M)” and insert “(N)”.

9 Delete lines 36 and 37 and insert:

10 “(O) Three members from state agencies with responsibility for water, land, air quality, natural
11 resources or infrastructure;”.

12 In line 38, delete “(O)” and insert “(P)”.

13 In line 40, delete “(P)” and insert “(Q)”.

14 On page 3, delete lines 5 and 6 and insert:

15 “(6) The council shall elect one of the council’s members to serve as chairperson and one
16 member to serve as vice chairperson. The council shall specify in the charter described in section
17 3 (1)(d) of this 2017 Act a process by which the council selects the chairperson and vice chairperson
18 and the terms of office for the chairperson and vice chairperson.”.

19 Delete lines 30 through 39 and insert:

20 “(a) Serve as the statewide governing body for sharing and managing geospatial framework data
21 that public bodies share under sections 1 to 6 of this 2017 Act;

22 “(b) Develop and update every four years a strategic plan to manage geospatial framework data
23 that aligns as closely as possible with the Enterprise Information Resources Management Strategy
24 described in ORS 291.039 and oversee the implementation of the plan;

25 “(c) Adopt, in consultation with the State Chief Information Officer, rules, policies and standards
26 that identify geospatial framework data that public bodies must share and that specify how fre-
27 quently public bodies must share the geospatial framework data;

28 “(d) Recommend an allocation of responsibilities among public bodies for collecting, using,
29 managing, sharing and maintaining geospatial framework data and devise and recommend terms
30 under which public bodies share geospatial framework data;”.

31 In line 40, delete “(d)” and insert “(e)”.

32 In line 42, delete “(e)” and insert “(f)”.

33 In line 45, delete “(f)” and insert “(g)”.

34 On page 4, delete lines 32 through 34 and insert:

35 “(G) Recommend to the Legislative Assembly strategies for eliminating the fees that public

1 bodies charge to other public bodies for geospatial framework data under ORS 190.050 or 192.440.”.

2 On page 6, delete lines 11 through 14 and insert:

3 “(C) Prohibit the sharing or redistribution of the public body’s geospatial framework data if the
4 public body notifies the Oregon Geographic Information Council in writing that the geospatial
5 framework data is exempt from disclosure under ORS 192.410 to 192.505 because the public body
6 claims a copyright or other proprietary interest in the geospatial framework data or for another
7 reason the public body specifies in the notice.”.

8 In line 31, delete “and”.

9 Delete line 32 and insert:

10 “(B) Protect the availability, integrity and confidentiality of the geospatial data library; and

11 “(C) Ensure that a recipient of geospatial framework data complies with the prohibitions a
12 public body places on sharing or redistributing the geospatial framework data under subsection
13 (2)(b)(C) of this section.”.

14 On page 7, delete lines 4 through 7 and insert:

15 “(4) The State Chief Information Officer may accept gifts, grants, donations and contributions
16 from the federal government or agencies of the federal government or from any other public or
17 private source and may agree to any conditions placed on the gift, grant, donation or contribution
18 that is in accordance with applicable law and sections 1 to 6 of this 2017 Act.”.

19 On page 8, delete lines 21 through 23 and insert:

20 “**SECTION 8. This 2017 Act takes effect on the 91st day after the date on which the 2017**
21 **regular session of the Seventy-ninth Legislative Assembly adjourns sine die.**”.
