House Bill 2918

Sponsored by Representative ESQUIVEL

SUMMARY

The following summary is not prepared by the sponsors of the measure and is not a part of the body thereof subject to consideration by the Legislative Assembly. It is an editor's brief statement of the essential features of the measure **as introduced**.

Prohibits introduction, propagation or stocking of wildlife species without authorization by law approved by Legislative Assembly. Imposes penalty not to exceed \$10,000. Applies to introduction, propagation or stocking of wildlife species on or after effective date of Act.

A BILL FOR AN ACT

2 Relating to nonnative species.

3 Be It Enacted by the People of the State of Oregon:

4 <u>SECTION 1.</u> Notwithstanding any other provision of law, a person may not introduce,

5 propagate or stock any wildlife species in the State of Oregon unless the introduction, prop-

agation or stocking of that species is authorized by a law approved by the Legislative As sembly.

8 <u>SECTION 2.</u> Violation of section 1 of this 2017 Act is punishable by a civil penalty, not 9 to exceed \$10,000. The imposition of a civil penalty under this section is subject to ORS 10 183.745. Any civil penalty recovered under this section shall be deposited in the Invasive 11 Species Control Account established under ORS 570.810. 12 <u>SECTION 3.</u> Section 1 of this 2017 Act applies to any introduction, propagation or stock-

13 ing of wildlife species that occurs on or after the effective date of this 2017 Act.
