2	"SECTION 1. (1) The Department of Environmental Quality shall study and propose rec-
3	ommendations on legislative, regulatory and other actions necessary to develop a program
4	that would allow parties the opportunity to conduct voluntary removal or remedial actions
5	at a facility under a single, coordinated process that, if completed successfully, would provide
6	the party with:
7	"(a) Release from liability under ORS 465.255, 466.640 and 468B.310; and
8	"(b) The ability to satisfy the requirements of, and to obtain certain releases from po-
9	tential liability under, the following federal laws as they may apply to the facility:
10	"(A) The federal Comprehensive Environmental Response, Compensation and Liability
11	Act, as amended, 42 U.S.C. 9601 et seq., P.L. 96-510 and P.L. 99-499;
12	"(B) The federal Resource Conservation and Recovery Act, 42 U.S.C. 6901 to 6992, P.L.
13	94-580, as amended; and
14	"(C) The federal Toxic Substances Control Act, 15 U.S.C. 2601 to 2671.
15	"(2) In conducting the study required by this section, the department shall:
16	"(a) Consult with the United States Environmental Protection Agency; and
17	"(b) Review and take into consideration actions by other states related to conducting
18	voluntary removal or remedial actions for the purpose of expanding or redeveloping real
19	property for affordable housing.
20	"(3) The department shall make a report of its findings and recommendations under
21	subsection (1) of this section and submit the report to the interim committees of the Legis-
22	lative Assembly related to the environment and natural resources in the manner provided
23	under ORS 192.245 no later than September 15, 2018.
24	"(4) As used in this section, 'remedial action' and 'removal' have the meaning given those
25	terms in ORS 465.200.
26	"SECTION 2. Section 1 of this 2017 Act is repealed on January 2, 2019.
27	"SECTION 3. This 2017 Act being necessary for the immediate preservation of the public
28	peace, health and safety, an emergency is declared to exist, and this 2017 Act takes effect
29	on its passage.".
