Requires Department of Transportation to study development of uniform speed bump height and markings.

Sunsets January 2, 2020.

2	Relating to transportation.
3	Be It Enacted by the People of the State of Oregon:
4	SECTION 1. (1) The Department of Transportation shall conduct a study of speed bumps
5	to examine the possibility of developing uniform standards for speed bump height and speed
6	bump markings and shall make a report on its findings.
7	(2) The department shall submit the report required by subsection (1) of this section, and
8	may include recommendations for legislation, to the interim committees of the Legislative
9	Assembly related to transportation in the manner provided under ORS 192.245 no later than
10	September 15, 2019.
11	SECTION 2. Section 1 of this 2017 Act is repealed on January 2, 2020.
