House Bill 3003

Sponsored by COMMITTEE ON HIGHER EDUCATION AND WORKFORCE DEVELOPMENT

SUMMARY

The following summary is not prepared by the sponsors of the measure and is not a part of the body thereof subject to consideration by the Legislative Assembly. It is an editor's brief statement of the essential features of the measure **as introduced.**

Requires each community college that receives state moneys for purpose of providing specific workforce development training to complete and return to Higher Education Coordinating Commission form detailing how moneys were used by community college and degree to which moneys achieved purpose for which moneys were expended.

Requires commission to combine forms from community colleges and submit report by November 15 of each year.

A BILL FOR AN ACT

- 2 Relating to workforce development training.
 - Be It Enacted by the People of the State of Oregon:
 - <u>SECTION 1.</u> (1) The Higher Education Coordinating Commission by rule shall develop a form to be completed annually by each community college that receives state moneys for the purpose of providing specific workforce development training. The form shall require the community college to detail:
 - (a) How the state moneys described in this subsection were used by the community college; and
 - (b) The degree to which the use of the state moneys described in this subsection achieved the purpose for which the moneys were expended.
 - (2) The commission by rule shall establish a date by which community colleges are required to complete and return the form developed under subsection (1) of this section.
 - (3) The commission shall combine the forms received from community colleges under this section and submit a report in the manner provided in ORS 192.245 to the interim legislative committees responsible for workforce development no later than November 15 of each year. The report:
 - (a) Shall describe and analyze the effectiveness of providing state moneys for the purpose of providing specific workforce development training at each community college that received such moneys during the previous 12 months; and
 - (b) May include recommendations for legislation.
 - SECTION 2. The Higher Education Coordinating Commission shall submit the first report required under section 1 of this 2017 Act no later than November 15, 2018.

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
