## **A-Engrossed** House Bill 3006

## SUMMARY

The following summary is not prepared by the sponsors of the measure and is not a part of the body thereof subject to consideration by the Legislative Assembly. It is an editor's brief statement of the essential features of the measure.

Requires State Forestry Department to identify Oregon-based contractors qualified to provide wildfire [fighting personnel, equipment and other resources] suppression equipment and post list of qualified contractors on website. [Requires department to use appropriate and available re-sources of qualified Oregon-based contractors before using other resources.] [Applies to fire seasons beginning on or after January 1, 2019.] Requires department to establish initial list of qualified contractors in time to use

wildfire suppression equipment of contractors for fire seasons beginning on or after January 1, 2018.

Takes effect on 91st day following adjournment sine die.

3	Be It Enacted by the People of the State of Oregon:
4	SECTION 1. Section 2 of this 2017 Act is added to and made a part of ORS chapter 477.
5	SECTION 2. The State Forestry Department shall establish a list of Oregon-based con-
6	tractors that the department determines to be qualified to supply the department with
7	wildfire suppression equipment. The department shall make the contractor list available on
8	a publicly accessible website.
9	SECTION 3. The State Forestry Department shall establish an initial list of qualified
10	Oregon-based contractors under section 2 of this 2017 Act in time to use the wildfire sup-
11	pression equipment of listed Oregon-based contractors for fire seasons beginning on or after
12	January 1, 2018.
13	SECTION 4. This 2017 Act takes effect on the 91st day after the date on which the 2017
14	regular session of the Seventy-ninth Legislative Assembly adjourns sine die.
