## House Bill 3006

Sponsored by Representative HAYDEN

## **SUMMARY**

The following summary is not prepared by the sponsors of the measure and is not a part of the body thereof subject to consideration by the Legislative Assembly. It is an editor's brief statement of the essential features of the measure **as introduced.** 

Requires State Forestry Department to identify Oregon-based contractors qualified to provide wildfire fighting personnel, equipment and other resources. Requires department to use appropriate and available resources of qualified Oregon-based contractors before using other resources. Applies to fire seasons beginning on or after January 1, 2019.

## A BILL FOR AN ACT

- Relating to wildfire fighting resources.
  - Be It Enacted by the People of the State of Oregon:
    - SECTION 1. Section 2 of this 2017 Act is added to and made a part of ORS chapter 477.
    - SECTION 2. (1) The State Forestry Department shall establish a list of Oregon-based contractors that the department determines to be qualified to supply the department with wildfire fighting personnel, equipment and other resources. To develop the list, the department shall evaluate Oregon-based contractors, determine the location, extent, nature and quality of contractor personnel, equipment and other resources that can respond to a dispatch order by the department, and rank equivalent contractors according to cost effectiveness.
    - (2) The department shall dispatch any appropriate and available resources of qualified Oregon-based contractors for the suppression or prevention of wildfires before obtaining resources for wildfire fighting contracted through a federal agency.
    - <u>SECTION 3.</u> The State Forestry Department shall establish an initial list of Oregonqualified contractors under section 2 of this 2017 Act in time to use the wildfire fighting resources of listed Oregon-based contractors for fire seasons beginning on or after January 1, 2019.
