3	"688.815. [(1) An applicant for a license to practice respiratory care shall:] The Health Licensing
4	Office may issue a license to practice respiratory care to an applicant who:
5	"[(a)] (1) [Submit] Submits to the [Health Licensing] office written evidence that the applicant:
6	"[(A)] (a) Is at least 18 years of age;
7	" $[(B)]$ (b) Has completed an approved four-year high school course of study or the equivalen
8	as determined by the appropriate educational agency; and
9	"[(C)] (c) [Has completed a respiratory care education program approved by the American Medica
10	Association in collaboration with the Joint Review Committee for Respiratory Therapy Education of
11	their successors or equivalent organizations, as approved by the Respiratory Therapist and Polysom
12	nographic Technologist Licensing Board; and] Holds an active credential conferred by the Na
13	tional Board for Respiratory Care, or its successor organization, as a Registered Respiratory
14	Therapist; and
15	"[(b)] (2) [Pass an examination] Passes any examinations approved by the Respiratory Ther
16	apist and Polysomnographic Technologist Licensing Board, including but not limited to an
17	examination regarding Oregon law and administrative rules related to the practice of re
18	spiratory care.
19	"[(2) An applicant meets the requirements of subsection (1)(a)(C) of this section if the applican
20	provides the office with documentation of military training or experience that the board determines is
21	substantially equivalent to the education required by subsection $(1)(a)(C)$ of this section.]
22	"[(3) The office may issue a license to practice respiratory care by endorsement or reciprocity to:]
23	"[(a) An applicant who is currently licensed to practice respiratory care under the laws of another
24	state, territory or country if the qualifications of the applicant are considered by the office to be
25	equivalent to those required in this state; or]
26	"[(b) An applicant holding an active credential conferred by the National Board for Respirator,
27	Care as a Certified Respiratory Therapist (CRT) or as a Registered Respiratory Therapist (RRT), or
28	both.]".

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
