

House Bill 3016

Sponsored by Representative EVANS; Representative CLEM

SUMMARY

The following summary is not prepared by the sponsors of the measure and is not a part of the body thereof subject to consideration by the Legislative Assembly. It is an editor's brief statement of the essential features of the measure **as introduced**.

Prohibits county zoning ordinance that prohibits keeping certain species of livestock in zone where keeping any species of livestock is permitted use.

A BILL FOR AN ACT

2 Relating to the keeping of livestock.

3 **Be It Enacted by the People of the State of Oregon:**

4 **SECTION 1. Section 2 of this 2017 Act is added to and made a part of ORS chapter 215.**

5 **SECTION 2. (1) As used in this section:**

6 (a) **"Keep" means to own, possess, control or otherwise have charge of livestock.**

7 (b) **"Livestock" means ratites, psittacines, horses, mules, jackasses, cattle, llamas,**
8 **alpacas, sheep, goats, swine, domesticated fowl and any fur-bearing animal bred and main-**
9 **tained commercially or otherwise, within pens, cages and hutches.**

10 (2) **A county may not prohibit by zoning ordinance the keeping of any species of livestock**
11 **on property located in a zone in which the keeping of one or more species of livestock is a**
12 **permitted use.**
