House Bill 3016

SUMMARY

The following summary is not prepared by the sponsors of the measure and is not a part of the body thereof subject to consideration by the Legislative Assembly. It is an editor's brief statement of the essential features of the measure **as introduced**.

Prohibits county zoning ordinance that prohibits keeping certain species of livestock in zone where keeping any species of livestock is permitted use.

A BILL FOR AN ACT

2 Relating to the keeping of livestock.

3 Be It Enacted by the People of the State of Oregon:

4 <u>SECTION 1.</u> Section 2 of this 2017 Act is added to and made a part of ORS chapter 215.

5 <u>SECTION 2.</u> (1) As used in this section:

6 (a) "Keep" means to own, possess, control or otherwise have charge of livestock.

7 (b) "Livestock" means ratites, psittacines, horses, mules, jackasses, cattle, llamas,

8 alpacas, sheep, goats, swine, domesticated fowl and any fur-bearing animal bred and main-

9 tained commercially or otherwise, within pens, cages and hutches.

10 (2) A county may not prohibit by zoning ordinance the keeping of any species of livestock

on property located in a zone in which the keeping of one or more species of livestock is a
permitted use.
