House Bill 3033

Sponsored by Representative JOHNSON

SUMMARY

The following summary is not prepared by the sponsors of the measure and is not a part of the body thereof subject to consideration by the Legislative Assembly. It is an editor's brief statement of the essential features of the measure **as introduced**.

Allows personal income taxpayers to subtract amounts paid as interest on qualified education loans from taxable income, in excess of amounts deducted on federal return.

Applies to interest paid in tax years beginning on or after January 1, 2017, and before January 1, 2023.

Takes effect on 91st day following adjournment sine die.

A BILL FOR AN ACT

2 Relating to income tax subtractions for student loan interest; and prescribing an effective date.

3 Be It Enacted by the People of the State of Oregon:

4 SECTION 1. Section 2 of this 2017 Act is added to and made a part of ORS chapter 316.

5 SECTION 2. (1) In computing Oregon taxable income for purposes of this chapter, there

6 shall be subtracted from federal taxable income an amount equal to the interest paid by a

7 taxpayer during the tax year on any qualified education loan.

- 8 (2) In computing Oregon taxable income for purposes of this chapter, there shall be added
- 9 to federal taxable income an amount equal to any deduction allowed the taxpayer for the tax

10 year under section 221 of the Internal Revenue Code.

<u>SECTION 3.</u> Section 2 of this 2017 Act applies to interest paid in tax years beginning on
or after January 1, 2017, and before January 1, 2023.

<u>SECTION 4.</u> This 2017 Act takes effect on the 91st day after the date on which the 2017
regular session of the Seventy-ninth Legislative Assembly adjourns sine die.

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
