House Bill 3074

Sponsored by Representative HACK

SUMMARY

The following summary is not prepared by the sponsors of the measure and is not a part of the body thereof subject to consideration by the Legislative Assembly. It is an editor's brief statement of the essential features of the measure **as introduced**.

Directs Department of Transportation to offer extended hours at field offices. Declares emergency, effective on passage.

A BILL FOR AN ACT 1 Relating to the Department of Transportation's hours of operation; and declaring an emergency. 2 Whereas the department's field offices serve approximately 13,000 Oregon residents daily; and 3 Whereas when the department closes all field offices on weekends, it reduces the time Oregon 4 residents may access services; and 5 6 Whereas field office locations that have offered Saturday service experience a high volume of 7 customers; and 8 Whereas the residents of Oregon are the customers of the department; and 9 Whereas the customers fund the paychecks of the department's employees; and Whereas the department closed the field offices that offer Saturday hours, forcing Oregon resi-10 dents to miss work in order to conduct business with the department; now, therefore, 11 12 Be It Enacted by the People of the State of Oregon: SECTION 1. (1) As used in this section, "field office" means a field office operated by the 13Department of Transportation where applications for driver licenses or motor vehicle regis-14 trations are accepted. 15(2) The department shall establish extended weekday and Saturday operating schedules 16

for field offices. The department shall extend the hours of operation beyond 5 p.m. Monday through Friday for at least half of the field offices. Additionally, at least half of the field offices shall operate on Saturday.

(3) After determining the hours of operation for field offices under subsection (2) of this
section, the department shall advertise the hours of operation in as many ways as practica ble, including but not limited to:

(a) Enclosing information about the hours of operation in all mailings and notices related
to driver licenses, motor vehicle titles and motor vehicle registrations;

25 (b) Posting the hours of operation at the field offices;

26 (c) Broadcasting public service announcements; and

27 (d) Using appropriate Internet and other electronic media services that may be available.

28 <u>SECTION 2.</u> This 2017 Act being necessary for the immediate preservation of the public 29 peace, health and safety, an emergency is declared to exist, and this 2017 Act takes effect 30 on its passage.
