

House Bill 3086

Sponsored by Representative MALSTROM; Representative MEEK

SUMMARY

The following summary is not prepared by the sponsors of the measure and is not a part of the body thereof subject to consideration by the Legislative Assembly. It is an editor's brief statement of the essential features of the measure **as introduced**.

Requires health benefit plan to reimburse cost of treatment for HIV-associated lipodystrophy.
Declares emergency, effective on passage.

A BILL FOR AN ACT

1
2 Relating to lipodystrophy treatment; and declaring an emergency.

3 **Be It Enacted by the People of the State of Oregon:**

4 **SECTION 1. Section 2 of this 2017 Act is added to and made a part of the Insurance Code.**

5 **SECTION 2. (1) A health benefit plan, as defined in ORS 743B.005, shall reimburse the**
6 **cost of treatment for lipodystrophy that is associated with human immunodeficiency virus.**

7 **(2) The coverage required by this section may be subject to cost-sharing requirements**
8 **applicable to other similar treatments reimbursed by the plan.**

9 **(3) This section is exempt from ORS 743A.001.**

10 **SECTION 3. Section 2 of this 2017 Act applies to health benefit plans for which the rates**
11 **have not been approved by the Department of Consumer and Business Services on or before**
12 **the effective date of this 2017 Act.**

13 **SECTION 4. This 2017 Act being necessary for the immediate preservation of the public**
14 **peace, health and safety, an emergency is declared to exist, and this 2017 Act takes effect**
15 **on its passage.**
