

# House Bill 3110

Sponsored by Representative ESQUIVEL; Representative WHISNANT

## SUMMARY

The following summary is not prepared by the sponsors of the measure and is not a part of the body thereof subject to consideration by the Legislative Assembly. It is an editor's brief statement of the essential features of the measure **as introduced**.

Establishes monthly salary for members of Legislative Assembly for months, any portion of which Legislative Assembly meets in organizational, regular or emergency session. Retains existing salary for pay periods beginning before January 1, 2019, and for interim months thereafter during which Legislative Assembly does not meet in session.

Becomes operative January 1, 2019.

## A BILL FOR AN ACT

2 Relating to legislator salaries; creating new provisions; and amending section 4, chapter 578, Oregon  
3 Laws 2013.

4 **Be It Enacted by the People of the State of Oregon:**

5 **SECTION 1. Section 2 of this 2017 Act is added to and made a part of ORS 292.907 to**  
6 **292.930.**

7 **SECTION 2. (1) A member of the Legislative Assembly shall receive for services per-**  
8 **formed during a month, any portion of which the Legislative Assembly is in organizational,**  
9 **regular or emergency session, a monthly salary of \$4,000.**

10 **(2) For months not described in subsection (1) of this section, a member of the Legisla-**  
11 **tive Assembly shall receive for services a monthly salary equal to the greater of:**

12 **(a) One step below the monthly maximum of Salary Range 1 in the Management Service**  
13 **Compensation Plan in the executive department as defined in ORS 174.112; or**

14 **(b) Seventeen percent of the monthly salary of a Circuit Court Judge.**

15 **(3) Salaries as determined under this section shall serve as the salaries described in ORS**  
16 **292.930 (12) and (13).**

17 **SECTION 3. Section 2 of this 2017 Act becomes operative January 1, 2019.**

18 **SECTION 4. Section 4, chapter 578, Oregon Laws 2013, as amended by section 5, chapter 840,**  
19 **Oregon Laws 2015, is amended to read:**

20 **Sec. 4.** The amendments to ORS 171.072, 292.912 and 292.930 by sections 1 to 3, chapter 578,  
21 Oregon Laws 2013, apply to salaries established for [*biennia beginning on or after July 1, 2017*]  
22 **calendar years beginning on or after January 1, 2019, or, if the context requires, biennia be-**  
23 **ginning on or after July 1, 2019.**
