House Bill 3117

SUMMARY

The following summary is not prepared by the sponsors of the measure and is not a part of the body thereof subject to consideration by the Legislative Assembly. It is an editor's brief statement of the essential features of the measure **as introduced.**

Directs each school district to designate individual or group of individuals to be advocate for educational reforms in school district.

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2 Relating to advocacy for educational reforms.

3 Be It Enacted by the People of the State of Oregon:

SECTION 1. Section 2 of this 2017 Act is added to and made a part of ORS chapter 329.

5 <u>SECTION 2.</u> (1) Each school district must designate an individual or a group of individ-6 uals to be an advocate for educational reforms in the school district.

7 (2) The individual or group of individuals designated under subsection (1) of this section
8 shall:

9 (a) Identify standards that would improve the effectiveness of educators in the school 10 district and the methods for meeting those standards;

(b) Identify tools that educators need to be more effective and to meet the needs of in dividual students, and the methods for providing those tools;

(c) Develop and revise cultural standards for the school district, including standards re lated to discipline, uniforms and inclusion of the arts and other creative learning techniques,
 and enforce those standards; and

(d) Examine any other issues identified by the superintendent of the school district that
 would enhance the quality of the classroom experience and improve high school graduation
 rates.

(3) The individuals or group of individuals designated under subsection (1) of this section
 may be compensated by the school district or may serve as volunteers.

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
