SUMMARY

The following summary is not prepared by the sponsors of the measure and is not a part of the body thereof subject to consideration by the Legislative Assembly. It is an editor's brief statement of the essential features of the measure.

Requires medical assistance coverage [of] for insertion of long-acting, reversible contraceptive devices during hospital stay for labor and delivery. Requires medical assistance coverage of removal of same device regardless of individual's eligibility for medical assistance.

2	Relating to medical assistance.
3	Be It Enacted by the People of the State of Oregon:
4	SECTION 1. Section 2 of this 2017 Act is added to and made a part of ORS chapter 414.
5	SECTION 2. Notwithstanding ORS 414.065 and 414.690, medical assistance must reim
6	burse, at a rate specified by the Oregon Health Authority, the cost to:
7	(1) Insert, postpartum, an intrauterine device or a progestin implant in an individual who
8	is eligible for medical assistance while the individual is admitted to a hospital for labor and
9	delivery; and
10	(2) Remove, at any time, an intrauterine device or progestin implant reimbursed under
11	subsection (1) of this section regardless of whether the individual is eligible for medical as
12	sistance.
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
