

House Bill 3135

Sponsored by Representative BUEHLER

SUMMARY

The following summary is not prepared by the sponsors of the measure and is not a part of the body thereof subject to consideration by the Legislative Assembly. It is an editor's brief statement of the essential features of the measure **as introduced**.

Requires medical assistance coverage of long-acting, reversible contraceptive devices during hospital stay for labor and delivery.

A BILL FOR AN ACT

2 Relating to medical assistance.

3 **Be It Enacted by the People of the State of Oregon:**

4 **SECTION 1. Section 2 of this 2017 Act is added to and made a part of ORS chapter 414.**

5 **SECTION 2. Notwithstanding ORS 414.065 and 414.690, medical assistance must reimburse**
6 **the cost, at a rate specified by the Oregon Health Authority, to insert an intrauterine device**
7 **or a progestin implant in a postpartum recipient of medical assistance while the recipient is**
8 **admitted to a hospital for labor and delivery.**

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NOTE: Matter in **boldfaced** type in an amended section is new; matter [*italic and bracketed*] is existing law to be omitted. New sections are in **boldfaced** type.
