## House Bill 3135

Sponsored by Representative BUEHLER

## **SUMMARY**

The following summary is not prepared by the sponsors of the measure and is not a part of the body thereof subject to consideration by the Legislative Assembly. It is an editor's brief statement of the essential features of the measure **as introduced.** 

Requires medical assistance coverage of long-acting, reversible contraceptive devices during hospital stay for labor and delivery.

1	A BILL FOR AN ACT
2	Relating to medical assistance.
3	Be It Enacted by the People of the State of Oregon:
4	SECTION 1. Section 2 of this 2017 Act is added to and made a part of ORS chapter 414.
5	SECTION 2. Notwithstanding ORS 414.065 and 414.690, medical assistance must reimburse
6	the cost, at a rate specified by the Oregon Health Authority, to insert an intrauterine device
7	or a progestin implant in a postpartum recipient of medical assistance while the recipient is
8	admitted to a hospital for labor and delivery.
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
