# B-Engrossed House Bill 3139

Ordered by the Senate May 22 Including House Amendments dated April 11 and Senate Amendments dated May 22

Sponsored by Representatives BUEHLER, WHISNANT, Senator KNOPP; Representative KENNEMER

### SUMMARY

The following summary is not prepared by the sponsors of the measure and is not a part of the body thereof subject to consideration by the Legislative Assembly. It is an editor's brief statement of the essential features of the measure.

Requires [Director of Oregon Business Development Department to adopt rules] Oregon Arts Commission to establish policies and procedures that ensure Arts Program considers regional differences in public access to, or opportunities for engagement in, arts and cultural development when determining eligibility for grant awards and that promote investment in communities where opportunities for engagement in arts and cultural development are limited.

[Directs Oregon Arts Commission to establish policies and procedures for grant programs administered by Arts Program that are consistent with rules adopted by director.]

Requires Oregon Arts Commission to suggest rules to Director of Oregon Business Development Department for grant programs administered by Arts Program.

4	Be It Enacted by the People of the State of Oregon:
5	SECTION 1. ORS 359.010 is amended to read:

- 7 [(1) "Administrator" means the Administrator of the Arts Program of the Oregon Business Devel-

19	359.025. (1) The Oregon Arts Commission shall perform the following duties:
20	(a) Serve as a body to advise governmental bodies and agencies and private persons on the de-
21	velopment and implementation of state policies and programs relating to the arts, heritage, historic
22	preservation, humanities and culture, and to assist in the coordination of these activities.
23	(b) Advise the Governor, the Director of the Oregon Business Development Department and the
24	Oregon Business Development Commission on all matters relating to the arts that pertain to the
25	powers, duties and functions of the Arts Program of the Oregon Business Development Department.
26	(c) Develop a recommended biennial budget for the operation of the Arts Program that will be
27	submitted to the director and the Governor.
28	(d) Seek and receive the views of all levels of government and the private sector with respect
29	to state programs and policies for the promotion and assistance of the arts.
30	(e) Prepare and submit suggested administrative rules to the director that the Oregon Arts
31	Commission determines are necessary for the operation of the programs of the Arts Program.
32	[(f) Establish policy and procedures for grant programs administered by the Arts Program.]
33	(f) Establish policies and procedures for grant programs administered by the Arts Pro-
34	gram, including polices and procedures that:
35	(A) Ensure that the criteria used to determine eligibility for grant awards are designed
36	to take into consideration the regional differences in public access to, or in opportunities for
37	engagement in, arts and cultural development in this state; and
38	(B) Promote investment in communities where opportunities for engagement in arts and
39	cultural development are limited.
40	(g) Suggest rules to the director for grant programs administered by the Arts Program,
41	including rules that are consistent with the policies and procedures established by the com-
42	mission under this section.
43	(2)(a) In addition to the duties imposed by subsection (1) of this section, the Oregon Arts Com-
44	mission shall establish policies and provide management and operational staff support for the Trust
45	for Cultural Development Board.

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(b) Notwithstanding paragraph (a) of this subsection, the Trust for Cultural Development Board 1 2 shall make any decisions relating to the investment and disbursement of moneys in the Trust for 3 Cultural Development Account. (1) The Director of the Oregon Business Development Department, upon consultation 5 with and the approval of the Oregon Arts Commission, shall appoint [an] the Administrator of the 6 Arts Program who shall serve at the pleasure of the director. 7 (2) The administrator shall receive such salary as may be provided by law or as fixed by the 8 9 director.
